

PhD position at KIT, Karlsruhe (Biology/Biophysics)

After successful funding of a collaborative SFB initiative involving research groups in Heidelberg, Karlsruhe and Göttingen (<http://sfb1324.de>), we have an open position for a PhD student at the Karlsruhe Institute of Technology (KIT), Germany. This is for an interdisciplinary project focused on analysis of molecular events of Wnt signalling at the membrane and we are looking for a Biologist who will work in close collaboration with Biophysicists.

The research project: Candidates are invited to apply to research group of Gary Davidson at KIT North Campus, who has a research focus on mechanisms that regulate Wnt receptor activation. A highly motivated, independent biologist is sought who will use cutting edge genetic (CRISPR/Cas) and Biophysical (advanced microscopy) technology to investigate Wnt receptor biology.

Candidate Requirements: Candidates should have a suitable degree in a biology related discipline and some practical experience in a research laboratory.
